- ► Tom Steman, University Archivist and Professor
- University Archives founded in March 1977 by SCSU president Charles Graham
- At St. Cloud State since 2007
- Before coming to St. Cloud State, staff archivist at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio
- Personal connections to central Minnesota

What is the St. Cloud State University Archives?

- Sole employee with a handful of motivated students
- ▶ 6-7 million documents, digital records
- Our mission is to document the people, property, policy, and programs of St. Cloud State founded in 1869 as Third State Normal School
- Celebrating SCSU sesquicentennial, September 2018 to September 2019
- Miller Center, third floor, room 314
- Open Monday through Friday, 8am-430pm I encourage appointments!
- Closed stacks, climate controlled, reading room for use
- ► Former Central Minnesota Historical Center under University Archives' umbrella
- Much high value material digitized and available anytime at no cost to patron

Institutional records can provide genealogical information. Some online, some not

Campus directories

- ▶ 1924 to 2015 online
- ► https://libsys.stcloudstate.edu/archon/?p=collections/findingaid&id=27&q
- Name, address, hometown, year in school
- Includes employees faculty, staff, administrators
- Information depends on the year

Course catalogs

- ▶ 1869-2012 in print
- https://libsys.stcloudstate.edu/archon/?p=collections/findingaid&id=16&q
- Trace curriculum, housing, tuition, fees, enrollment, almost everything, to 1869
- List of students from 1870s to 1920s by class, sometimes model school students, too
- List of faculty members information changes over time

Alumni directories

- Alumni directories for 1908, 1940, 1992 and 1998

- 2010 alumni directory available in University Archives

Transcript index

- Dates from mid-1870s to late 1930s
- http://www.stcloudstate.edu/library/archives/histories/transcript-index.aspx
- ▶ Index to nearly 20,000 names in 15 volumes in University Archives
- Lists name, age when entered, hometown, father's name, father's occupation, family nationality, and school last attended
- Lindbergh connection Evangeline and Lillian Lindbergh both entered St. Cloud State in January 1908

- **1902-1904**, **1922-2003**

- Classes, student activities, athletics, faculty/staff/administrators

Commencement programs

- ▶ 1871-present, with a few missing

- List students, their degree, hometown, and any honors

Student newspapers

- Three student newspapers: Normalia (1892-1904), Normal School Recorder (1916-1918), and the Chronicle (1924-present)

WPA biographical sketches

- Done by WPA workers in mid-1930s; helped establish Stearns History Museum!

- Contains 1500+ names with interviews often done by children and/or spouses of the subject
- Some are simply information copied from published sources

Archon portal

- Archon portal located at: https://libsys.stcloudstate.edu/archon/index.php
- ▶ 10,000 digital objects, mostly images
- ▶ 60+ finding aids to "processed" archival material
- Search across digital objects, finding aids, subject headings, and name
- Search and download images no cost, no signup, no nothing
- Ask that the University Archives is properly credited
