Session 1: "Let Man Not Put Asunder: Using Marriage, Divorce, Guardianship and Court Records to Reconstruct an Early 19th Century Life." Ancestors married and moved. Spouses died. Widowers remarried. Blended families appeared in the census. Divorces happened. From a Kentucky-Indiana frontier case study, learn how to use a variety of records to reconstruct what really happened in the early 1800s.

Session 2: "Documenting the Immigration Trail: A

Five-stage Approach." Immigration was a chain of events: preparations to leave home, embarkation at a port, arrival in an American port, getting established in a new community, and gaining U.S. citizenship. Learn how to use records to document the entire process.

Session 3: "Finding your pre-1850 American

Ancestors." American genealogy becomes more challenging before 1850, when the U.S. Census first listed every individual in a household. Researchers must turn to other records, including tax lists, estate records and court records to reconstruct pre-1850 families.

J. H. "Jay" Fonkert is a professional researcher with experience in Midwest, Dutch, English, Swedish and Norwegian research, with special interests in migration and geography. He has had research experience at the Minnesota History Center and other Midwest libraries. He was Past-president, Minnesota Genealogical

Society, winner of the 2009 Scholar Award from American Society of Genealogists, and place-winner in the International Society of Family History Writers and Editors writing competition, 2007, 2008 and 2009. He is a columnist for *The Septs*, journal of the Irish Genealogical Society, International, and an instructor in an Intermediate Genealogy Course sponsored by MN Genealogical Society, as well as a conference speaker and lecturer.
